

# **CLU CONTACT LENS STUDY**

# WHAT IS THE GOAL OF THE STUDY?

To evaluate the lens fit characteristics of an investigational contact lens.

# WHO MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE STUDY?

Those who meet the following criteria may be eligible to participate:

- Age 18 and over
- Contact lenses prescription between -2.00 and -4.00 D, astigmatism ≤ 0.50 D in each eye
- Must be willing to wear study lenses for a minimum of 6 hours per day
- Must have spectacles and be willing to wear them when study lenses are not worn
- Successful wearer of spherical soft contact lenses for a minimum of 5 days per week and minimum 6 hours per day during the past 3 months
- Have normal, healthy eyes with good corrected vision

Further screening questions will be asked prior to scheduling an appointment.

### WHAT DOES THE STUDY INVOLVE?

Participants will be screened with an eye examination to verify that they meet the requirements of the study.

The study involves a total of 4 office visits over a period of 2 to 3 days. Subjects will be asked to wear two different types of soft contact lenses. The lenses will be provided at no cost.

### WILL I BENEFIT FROM PARTICIPATING?

There is no expected direct benefit, however your participation may benefit future patients.

### WHAT ELSE SHOULD I KNOW?

Participants will be compensated up to \$220 for their time.
